

Weekly markets and night markets – day by day

Even though the selection of food and drinks in the French supermarkets is quite amazing, there's nothing like going to the (usually weekly – in the morning) local market to pick your favourite delicacies or just have a stroll and a coffee. Here's a list of markets in a circle of around 25 km from Levignac de Guyenne – with a few special ones a bit further away. In our opinion, the best of them, combining size, setting and atmosphere, are Eymet and Issigeac – but try them out for yourself and find your own favourites.

Weekly night markets in the summer in the summertime.

This southwestern part of France has a huge selection of weekly night markets – with slightly different names in the individual villages and towns. But the concept is rather similar and very attractive: Rows of tables and chairs and a fine selection of stalls and vans with food and drinks – generally fine quality and very reasonable prices. Most places also have live music during the night – and some of them even have a few non-food stalls. Best of all is the unique atmosphere when lots of people, French as well as expats, meet up for a cozy night out – and every single town and village has its own special touch and feel to it.

Here's the list for 2023:

Tuesday	Eymet – Marché nocturne – June 27th to August 29th, 2023 – centered around Place Gambetta and a combination of the local restaurants, food trucks and a few souvenirs and crafts stalls Monteton – Soirées gourmandes – July 18th to August 22nd, 2023 (fireworks July 25th) – stunning views from the location on the (usual) parking lot. Usually rather busy (the good way!) and always live music
Wednesday	Monségur – Marché nocturne – June 21st to September 6th, 2023 – centered around the beautiful La Halle (market hall) at Place Robert Darniche with good selection of food and drinks Allemans-du-Dropt – Mercredi Cachés – July 5th to August 30th 2023 – see Special events below
Thursday	Duras – Marchés nocturnes – June 29th to August 31st, 2023 - one of the largest night markets filling the two central squares, Place du 11 Novembre and Place Jean Bousquet. Great selection of food and drinks, always live music and often with a light show on the beautiful chateau walls Issigeac – Marché gourmand – July 6th to September 7th, 2023 –Issigeac is really stunning Eymet – Les apéros Cadix (in the garden next to the chateau – no dates released for 2023) – run by the local farmer's association, Comice Agricole, and therefore with only local (and

Thursday	good!) food and drinks in the stalls. Also live music followed by a DJ. Beautiful setting in the garden!
Friday	Lévig-nac-de-Guyenne – Marché nocturne – June 30th to August 25 2023 – Beautiful setting around Place de la Halle and the old market hall. Good selection of food and drinks and usually a combination of live music and the iconic (VERY experienced) local DJ – lots of dancing! La Sauvetat-du-Dropt – Marché gourmande – July 7th to July 28th 2023 – set at La Prairie – the green area between the village and the Dropt River – this is another nice and cozy night market with a very local feel, good food and drinks and always with live music.
Sunday	Soumensac – Marché des producteurs – July 2nd to September 3rd 202 – set at Chemin de Ronde, the path along the outside of the village, this LUNCHTIME (11-14.30) summer market offers a beautiful view from its elevated position and a good selection of local food and drinks.

Special events on top of the traditional night markets

In [Allemans-du-Dropt](#), there's the Mercredis Cachés ("hidden Wednesdays") every Wednesday from July 5th to August 30th at 8.30 pm. You simply turn up at the central square, Place de la Liberté, and signs will tell you the way to the secret spot of this night's concert – also with a secret artist. Get ready to be (pleasantly) surprised for new places and music every week – and there's also a few stalls with food and drinks.

Also in [Allemans-du-Dropt](#) is the great celebration of Bastille Day, which in 2023 will be Friday July 14th . Starting at 7 pm with food and drink stalls and night market atmosphere, the great finish is fireworks across from the mill pond, best seen from the bridge if you arrive early enough. A true highlight for our summer every year – more details here!

Fête de la Musique started in 1982 and is a big event around France, always on June 21st. Locally it's celebrated in [Saint-Pierre-sur-Dropt](#) with bands, disco, food and drinks – usually a very big event with a great atmosphere – follow updates on local [Facebook](#).
